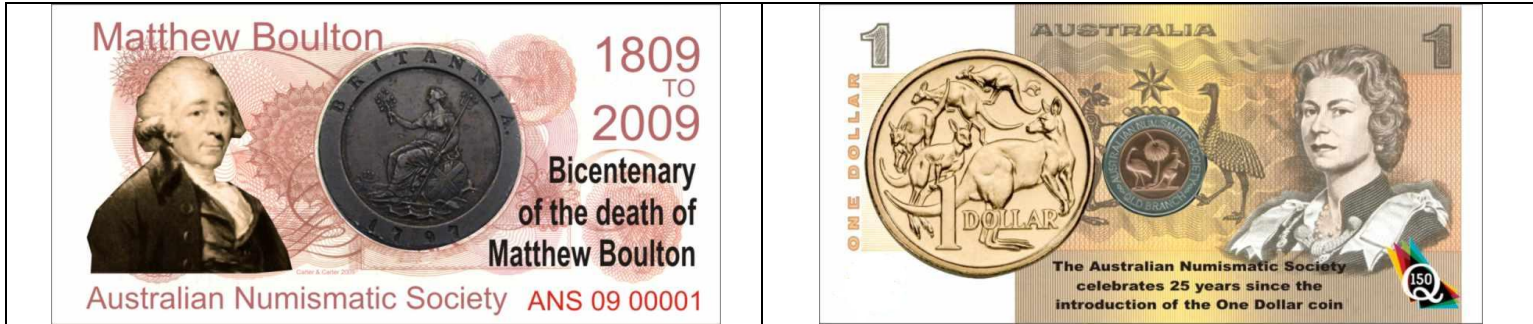

The Queensland Branch is now taking orders for the first ANS commemorative notegeld marking the
200th Anniversary of the death of Matthew Boulton / 25th Anniversary of introduction of \$1 coin



Matthew Boulton can be considered the founder of modern coining processes with his steam driven coining press. It was from these presses at his Heaton Mint near Birmingham that he struck the now famous “cartwheel” penny along with farthing, halfpenny and tuppenny pieces, many of which found their way to the Australian Colony of New South Wales and now considered part of our Proclamation coinage. In recognition of the achievements of Matthew Boulton to the world of numismatics, the Australian Numismatic Society has commissioned this commemorative note to mark the Bicentenary of his death which occurred on 17th August 1809.

The other side of the note celebrates the introduction of the now iconic “Mob of Roos” one dollar coin in 1984 which replaced the one dollar note first introduced in 1966. To mark the 25th anniversary of the demise of the one dollar paper note and introduction of the one dollar coin, ANS has joined these two commemorations on the one note.

In recognition of Queensland’s Sesquicentenary 1859-2009, a maximum of only 150 of these commemorative notes will be available to the public. Orders for this commemorative note, the first produced by ANS, will be accepted up to Separation Day, 10th December 2009. Notes have their own unique serial number and demand cannot exceed the limit of 150 only. Serial numbers ANS09 000001 and ANS09 000149 have been reserved. There are also six specimen notes with serial numbers ANS09 000000 reserved for the ANS, ANS Qld Branch and the three other Queensland societies and one for the note designer.

To secure your piece of numismatic paper history, please fill in the order form below and return it to the Honorary Treasurer at above address. This commemorative note is available for only \$5 plus postage and handling however if you wish to secure a specific serial number you can “make an offer”, the highest offer will secure that number. All offers close on 23rd October and no order for random serials will be accepted after 10th December. Those with highest offer for a serial number will be notified so please include phone or email details. Notes will be posted to collectors as soon as possible after 23rd October upon receipt of payment and processing of order.
